Answers to Frequently Asked Questions:

Auditions are open to all non-union performers, regardless of age, ability and experience.

Costs: Cast fees are due at the time of audition and include the cost of costume rental and script. Additionally, a small donation to our program and gala are requested.

Generally, rehearsals are in the evenings during the week and performances are on the weekends.

Multiple performers are cast in each part. Generally, cast members will be assigned between 25% and 50% of performance. Schedule conflicts are taken into consideration prior to show schedule posting.

One of the most popular musicals of the last half century, The Music Man will march into your heart as con man Harold Hill brings a boy's band to River City, Iowa, and finds love along the way.

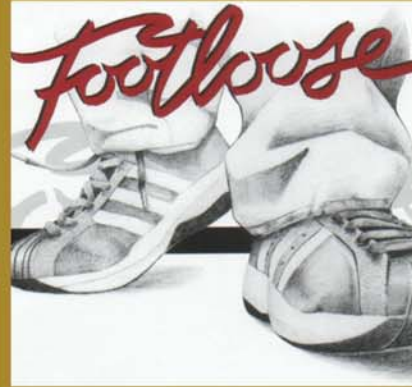
